Qualification Description

Bachelor's Degree Program: Bulgarian Philology

1. Aims and Educational Objectives

The main aim of the Bachelor's degree program in Bulgarian Philology is the formation of highly qualified specialists in Bulgarian language and literature with a broad academic foundation. The training is oriented towards the acquisition of in-depth philological knowledge combined with the development of practical skills for its application.

The program provides qualified specialists for the needs of the secondary school. Students wishing to acquire the professional qualification "Teacher" can choose an elective module which equips them with the pedagogical and methodological knowledge and skills for teaching Bulgarian language and literature at secondary school level.

2. Description of the educational content (knowledge and skills required for a successful professional realization; general and theoretical background, specific areas of study, etc.)

During the course of study, students are given a solid philological background and knowledge in a number of linguistic and literary disciplines. They also acquire practical skills for its application in various spheres of public life.

The curriculum includes compulsory, elective and optional courses ensuring that students are equipped with a sound academic foundation as well as offering them the opportunity to acquire specialized knowledge in areas of their own choice.

Two elective modules are offered within the program. In the module leading to the acquisition of the professional qualification "Teacher," the students acquire competences in organizing and managing the process of teaching Bulgarian language and literature at secondary school level; they develop skills for working with students and master innovative methods of teaching in a digital environment. The Language Technologies module prepares students in the field of linguistic computer programming and provides them with philological knowledge oriented to the needs of the digital age.

The curriculum of the degree program also includes an optional free-standing specialized module with disciplines focused on project management and entrepreneurship.

3. Professional and general competences, specific competences

Students graduate with the educational and qualification degree "Bachelor" and professional qualification "Bulgarian Philologist." All successful graduates of the program are fully trained specialists in the area of philology and Bulgarian language and literature, as well as having a broader range of competences in the humanities and in interdisciplinary fields. They are equipped with specialized skills in doing research and creating knowledge in the areas of philology and the humanities.

Graduates with the professional qualification "Teacher" are qualified in the methodology of teaching Bulgarian language and literature and have competences that allow them to work in different learning environments in the secondary school. Graduates with the qualification "Language Technology Specialist" are qualified in the field of language technology and computer linguistics.

4.
